- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section
- 2 60-3,122.03, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change
- 3 provisions relating to Military Honor Plates; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 60-3,122.03, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,122.03 (1) The department shall design license plates to be
- 4 known as Military Honor Plates. The department shall create designs
- 5 honoring persons who have served or are serving in the United States
- 6 Army, United States Army Reserve, United States Navy, United States Navy
- 7 Reserve, United States Marine Corps, United States Marine Corps Reserve,
- 8 United States Coast Guard, United States Coast Guard Reserve, United
- 9 States Air Force, United States Air Force Reserve, Army National Guard,
- 10 or Air National Guard. There shall be twelve eleven designs, one for each
- 11 of such armed forces reflecting its official emblem, official seal, or
- 12 other official image. The issuance of plates for each of such armed
- 13 forces shall be conditioned on the approval of the armed forces owning
- 14 the copyright to the official emblem, official seal, or other official
- 15 image. A person may qualify for a Military Honor Plate by registering
- 16 with the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to section 80-414. The
- 17 Department of Motor Vehicles shall verify the applicant's eligibility for
- 18 a plate created pursuant to this section by consulting the registry
- 19 established by the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- 20 (2) The design shall be selected on the basis of limiting the
- 21 manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than or equal to the
- 22 amount charged for license plates pursuant to section 60-3,102. The
- 23 Department of Motor Vehicles shall make applications available for each
- 24 type of plate when it is designed. The department may adopt and
- 25 promulgate rules and regulations to carry out this section and section
- 26 60-3,122.04.
- 27 (3) One type of Military Honor Plates shall be alphanumeric plates.
- 28 The department shall:
- 29 (a) Assign a designation up to five characters; and
- 30 (b) Not use a county designation.
- 31 (4) One type of Military Honor Plates shall be personalized message

1 plates. Such plates shall be issued subject to the same conditions

- 2 specified for personalized message license plates in section 60-3,118,
- 3 except that a maximum of five characters may be used.
