- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
- 2 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to adopt the
- 3 Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act; to provide penalties and
- 4 eliminate a penalty; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original
- 5 section; and to outright repeal section 28-635, Reissue Revised
- 6 Statutes of Nebraska.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357 and 28-1601 to 28-1603 and
- 4 sections 2 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 5 Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. This act shall be known and may be cited as the Counterfeit
- 7 Airbag Prevention Act.
- 8 Sec. 3. For purposes of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act,
- 9 unless the context otherwise requires:
- 10 <u>(1) Airbag means a motor vehicle inflatable occupant restraint</u>
- 11 system device that is part of a supplemental restraint system;
- 12 <u>(2) Counterfeit supplemental restraint system component means a</u>
- 13 <u>supplemental restraint system component that displays a mark identical or</u>
- 14 substantially similar to the genuine mark of a motor vehicle manufacturer
- 15 <u>or a supplier of parts to the manufacturer of a motor vehicle without</u>
- 16 authorization from such manufacturer or supplier;
- 17 (3) Nonfunctional airbag means an airbag that meets any of the
- 18 <u>following criteria:</u>
- 19 <u>(a) The airbag was previously deployed or damaged;</u>
- 20 <u>(b) The airbag has an electric fault that is detected by the motor</u>
- 21 vehicle's diagnostic system when the installation procedure is completed
- 22 and the motor vehicle is returned to the customer who requested the work
- 23 to be performed;
- (c) The airbag includes a part or object, including, but not limited
- 25 to, a supplemental restraint system component, installed in a motor
- 26 <u>vehicle to mislead the owner or operator of the motor vehicle into</u>
- 27 <u>believing that a functional airbag has been installed; or</u>
- 28 (d) The airbag is subject to the prohibitions of subsection (j) of
- 29 49 U.S.C. 30120, as such section existed on January 1, 2019; and
- 30 (4) Supplemental restraint system means an inflatable restraint
- 31 system as defined in 49 C.F.R. 571.208, as such regulation existed on

1 January 1, 2019, designed for use in conjunction with an active safety

- 2 system. A supplemental restraint system includes one or more airbags and
- 3 all components required to ensure that an airbag works as designed by the
- 4 motor vehicle manufacturer, including both of the following:
- 5 <u>(a) The airbag operates as necessary in the event of a crash; and</u>
- 6 (b) The airbag is designed in accordance with federal motor vehicle
- 7 <u>safety standards for the specific make, model, and year of the motor</u>
- 8 vehicle in which it is or will be installed.
- 9 Sec. 4. A person violates the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act if
- 10 the person does any of the following:
- 11 (1) Knowingly and intentionally manufactures, imports, installs,
- 12 reinstalls, distributes, sells, or offers for sale any device intended to
- 13 replace a supplemental restraint system component in any motor vehicle if
- 14 the device is a counterfeit supplemental restraint system component, a
- 15 <u>nonfunctional airbag</u>, or does not meet federal safety requirements as
- 16 provided in 49 C.F.R. 571.208, as such regulation existed on January 1,
- 17 2019;
- 18 (2) Knowingly and intentionally sells, installs, or reinstalls a
- 19 device that causes a motor vehicle's diagnostic system to fail to warn
- 20 when the motor vehicle is equipped with a counterfeit supplemental
- 21 restraint system component or a nonfunctional airbag or when no airbag is
- 22 installed;
- 23 (3) Knowingly and intentionally represents to another person that a
- 24 <u>counterfeit</u> supplemental restraint system component or nonfunctional
- 25 airbag installed in a motor vehicle is not a counterfeit supplemental
- 26 restraint system component or a nonfunctional airbag; or
- 27 <u>(4) Causes another person to violate this section or assists another</u>
- 28 person in violating this section.
- 29 Sec. 5. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
- 30 violation of the Counterfeit Airbag Prevention Act is a Class IV felony.
- 31 (2) A violation of the act is a Class IIIA felony if the defendant

- 1 <u>has been previously convicted of a violation of the act.</u>
- 2 (3) A violation of the act is a Class III felony if the violation
- 3 <u>resulted in an individual suffering bodily injury.</u>
- 4 (4) A violation of the act is a Class IIA felony if the violation
- 5 <u>resulted in an individual suffering serious bodily injury.</u>
- 6 (5) A violation of the act is a Class II felony if the violation
- 7 resulted in the death of an individual.
- 8 Sec. 6. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 9 Supplement, 2018, is repealed.
- Sec. 7. The following section is outright repealed: Section 28-635,
