- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-10,138,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide duties for the
- 3 State Department of Education and school districts relating to
- 4 school meals as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-10,138, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 79-10,138 (1) The State Department of Education shall reimburse
- 4 each qualified public school in Nebraska a portion of the cost of such
- 5 school's school breakfast program in the amount of five cents per school
- 6 breakfast served by such school in the second preceding school year. To
- 7 qualify, a school district shall operate a school lunch program and shall
- 8 submit information regarding the number of breakfasts served in a manner
- 9 prescribed by the department. The Legislature shall appropriate money
- 10 from the General Fund to carry out this section.
- 11 (2) The department shall promote practices to prevent and reduce
- 12 student debt for school breakfasts and lunches. On or before January 1,
- 13 <u>2020, the department shall create and disseminate a uniform meal charge</u>
- 14 policy that school districts may implement. The meal policy shall
- include, but not be limited to, the following provisions:
- 16 (a) Each student shall be served a reimbursable meal upon request at
- 17 <u>each meal during each school day, regardless of whether such student can</u>
- 18 <u>immediately pay for the meal or has accrued debt for school meals;</u>
- 19 (b) Each school district shall communicate directly with a parent or
- 20 guardian of a student to address outstanding debt for school meals,
- 21 rather than communicate with or through a student, and shall not engage
- 22 in practices directed at the student that may stigmatize the student,
- 23 including, but not limited to, requiring the student to work off a debt;
- 24 (c) A school district shall not discard any school meal after it is
- 25 served to a student on the basis that the student is unable to pay for
- 26 the meal or has debt for school meals;
- 27 <u>(d) Each school district shall endeavor to ensure that student meals</u>
- 28 are not being charged to students eligible for free or reduced priced
- 29 school meals by attempting to directly certify student eligibility or by
- 30 <u>encouraging parents and guardians to apply for eligibility through the</u>
- 31 application process; and

- 1 (e) Each school district shall evaluate their unpaid meal charge
- 2 <u>collection policies and consider whether collection is appropriate based</u>
- 3 on the income and circumstances of the family with the unpaid debt for
- 4 <u>school meals.</u>
- 5 (3) The department may include or create additional school meal
- 6 charge policies consistent with the requirements in subsection (2) of
- 7 this section.
