- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicle registration; to amend section 60-3,156, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change a fee; to create a fund; to provide for distribution of funds for the simulation in motion program of the University of Nebraska Medical Center; to harmonize provisions; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original section.

- 3 60-3,156 In addition to the registration fees for motor vehicles and
- 4 trailers, the county treasurer or his or her agent shall collect:
- 5 (1) Two dollars for each certificate issued and shall remit two
- 6 dollars of each additional fee collected to the State Treasurer for
- 7 credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund;
- 8 (2) Fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall remit the fee
- 9 to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Emergency Medical
- 10 System Operations Fund; and
- 11 (3) One dollar and fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall
- 12 remit the fee to the State Treasurer for credit to the State Recreation
- 13 Road Fund; and -
- 14 (4) Fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall remit the fee
- 15 to the State Treasurer for credit to the University of Nebraska Medical
- 16 Center Simulation in Motion-Nebraska Fund.
- 17 Sec. 2. <u>There is hereby created the University of Nebraska Medical</u>
- 18 Center Simulation in Motion-Nebraska Fund. The fund may receive gifts,
- 19 <u>bequests, grants, fees, or other contributions or donations from public</u>
- 20 or private entities. The fund shall be used to carry out the simulation
- 21 in motion program of the University of Nebraska Medical Center, including
- 22 training first responders, out-of-hospital emergency care providers, and
- 23 <u>critical-access-hospital staff in rural areas. Any money in the fund not</u>
- 24 used to defray the annual operating expenses of the simulation in motion
- 25 program shall be used to establish a subaccount to fund expenses related
- 26 <u>to the depreciation of the equipment used in the simulation in motion</u>
- 27 program. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested
- 28 by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital
- 29 <u>Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.</u>
- 30 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on August 1, 2020.
