LEGISLATIVE BILL 944A

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 944, One Hundred
- 3 Sixth Legislature, Second Session, 2020; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$18,000 from the
2 License Plate Cash Fund for FY2020-21 and (2) \$36,000 from the License
3 Plate Cash Fund for FY2021-22 to the Department of Motor Vehicles, for
4 Program 90, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
5 944, One Hundred Sixth Legislature, Second Session, 2020.

6 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
7 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
8 section.

9 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$5,950 from the Support
10 the Arts Cash Fund for FY2020-21 and (2) \$18,150 from the Support the
11 Arts Cash Fund for FY2021-22 to the Nebraska Arts Council, for Program
12 327, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 944, One
13 Hundred Sixth Legislature, Second Session, 2020.

14 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
15 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
16 section.

17 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$5,950 from the Pets for
18 Vets Cash Fund for FY2020-21 and (2) \$18,150 from the Pets for Vets Cash
19 Fund for FY2021-22 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for Program
20 511, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 944, One
21 Hundred Sixth Legislature, Second Session, 2020.

22 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
23 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
24 section.

25 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
