- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 44-7,105, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2018, is amended to read:

(1) Notwithstanding section 44-3,131, (a) (1) 3 44-7,105 an 4 individual or group sickness or accident policy, certificate, or subscriber contract delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this 5 state and a hospital, medical, or surgical expense-incurred policy, (b) 6 7 (2) a self-funded employee benefit plan to the extent not preempted by federal law, and (c) (3) a certificate, agreement, or contract to provide 8 limited health services issued by a prepaid limited health service 9 organization, as defined in section 44-4702, shall not include a 10 provision, stipulation, or agreement establishing or limiting any fees 11 charged for dental services that are not covered by the policy, 12 certificate, contract, agreement, or plan and shall not include any 13 restrictions on methods of claim payment for dental services made by the 14 policy, certificate, contract, agreement, or plan in which the only 15 acceptable payment method is a credit card payment or granting access to 16 17 its dental services provider network contract to a third party unless the requirements of subsection (2) of this section are met. 18

19 (2) An insurer or any of its affiliates party to the dental services
 20 provider network contract may grant access to the dental services
 21 provider network contract to a third party if:

22 (a) At the time the dental services provider network contract is entered into and at the time the dental services provider network 23 24 contract is renewed or amended, the insurer allows any provider who is 25 part of the insurer's dental services provider network to choose not to participate in third-party access to the dental services provider network 26 contract. The third-party access provision of any dental services 27 provider network contract shall be clearly identified in the dental 28 services provider network contract in twelve-point underlined text. An 29 30 insurer or any of its affiliates party to the dental services provider network contract shall not grant third-party access to the dental 31

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1 services provider network contract of any provider who does not 2 participate in third-party access; (b) The insurer includes on its web site a listing identifying all 3 4 third parties who have been granted such access to the dental services 5 provider network contract and which is updated at least once every ninety 6 days; and 7 (c) The third party accessing the dental services provider network 8 contract agrees to comply with all of the dental services provider 9 network contract's terms. 10 (3) A provider is not required to perform, and is not bound by, any contract or agreement entered into after the effective date of this act 11 12 to perform, dental treatment or services under a dental services provider 13 network contract granted to a third party in violation of this section.
