LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 303

Introduced by Gragert, 40.

WHEREAS, the Hartington-Newcastle High School one act team won the 2019 NSAA Class C-2 State Play Production Championship; and

WHEREAS, the Hartington-Newcastle Wildcats earned their first place finish with a score of 176 points for their production of Young Frankenstein, narrowly defeating the Loup City Rebels by three points; and

WHEREAS, under the direction of head coach A.J. Johnson, Hartington-Newcastle has earned three state championship titles in a row; and

WHEREAS, senior Sam Harms earned the Class C-2 Outstanding Male Performer for the third year in a row; and

WHEREAS, the Hartington-Newcastle Wildcats have proven themselves to be a powerhouse in one act productions, having won the Class C-2 State Play Production Championship eight times since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the academic, athletic, and artistic achievements of the youth of our state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:
