- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST
- 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2020, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To add a new section 14 to Article VIII:
- 7 <u>VIII-14</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 8 Constitution, the Legislature shall provide by law for a refundable
- 9 <u>credit against the income tax imposed by the State of Nebraska in an</u>
- 10 <u>amount equal to thirty-five percent of the property taxes that were:</u>
- 11 (a) Levied on real property located in this state; and
- 12 <u>(b) Paid by the taxpayer during the taxable year.</u>
- 13 (2) The Legislature shall make the credit available for taxable
- 14 years beginning on or after January 1, 2021.
- 15 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 16 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 17 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 18 A constitutional amendment to require the Legislature to provide a
- 19 refundable state income tax credit in an amount equal to thirty-five
- 20 percent of the property taxes that were levied on real property located
- 21 in this state and paid by the taxpayer during the taxable year.
