## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB107**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 107 updates the statutes as it relates to plumbing boards including:

- 1) Extending the term of office for the plumbers on the board from 3 years to 4 years.
- 2) Eliminating the requirement that the plumbing board be appointed in August of each year
- 3) Eliminating the requirement that the plumbing board meets every two weeks and requires board to meet at least once each year.
- 4) Establishing the fee for a plumbing license be set by the City Council.
- 5) Establishing the penalty as a misdemeanor and the fine be more than \$500 and not less than \$50.
- 6) Permitting cities and villages to apply other applicable regulations, such as continuing education, as part of plumbing licensing.
- 7) Making other various clean-up and harmonizing changes.
