The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB1162 would create the Fueling Station Tax Credit Act. This Act provides for a nontransferable and non-refundable income tax credit for work completed in years 2020 and 2021 to create a comprehensive electric vehicle charging station network across the state. LB1162 would also provide that any taxpayer claiming credits under the Act submit an annual report to the Department of Environment and Energy detailing the number of charging events, the number of unique vehicles that were charged, the number of total kilowatt hours dispensed for each charging event and the average kilowatt-hours dispensed for all charging events.
