Introducer's Statement of Intent LB205 Chairperson: Senator Sara Howard Committee: Health and Human Services Date of Hearing: January 23, 2019 The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby: LB 205 adopts the Surgical Technologist Registry Act, the result of a recommendation from the Surgical Technologist "407" review by the Department of Health and Human Services in 2016. Additionally, LB 205 adds clarifying language in statute by allowing licensed medical professionals to assign tasks to skilled professional or nonprofessional assistants who are licensed, certified, or registered by the state if the assigned tasks are appropriate to their skill.

Nebraska is the only state in the country that does not have a statute explaining when

delegation of tasks by licensed medical professionals is appropriate.
