The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 26 simply clarifies the definition of legal expense insurance to allow for modern day plans that pay an administrative fee to an attorney so that it is not considered payment or reimbursement for specified legal services. The bill also adds an exemption to the statute excluding from regulation plans that do not include the assumption of risk or obligation to pay or reimburse for specified legal services or specified legal expenses.
