The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB332 revises provisions of the Young Adult Bridge to Independence Act based upon the recommendations of the Nebraska Children's Commission's Bridge to Independence Advisory Committee. The bill adds criteria to expand eligible youth, decreases payments to some eligible participants, and eliminates potentially duplicative payments to other eligible youth participants.
