The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB382 amends the Dog and Cat Purchase Protection Act. The bill proposes several changes including; A ban on the sale of dogs produced by breeding a parent dog with their offspring; Adds and amends records requirements on pet stores including requiring records be available for customer review, and maintaining said records for one year after the purchase of a pet from the selling pet shop; Applies the act uniformly statewide.
