The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 388 seeks to codify case law and update proceedings as it relates to juvenile court proceedings, termination of parental rights, guardianship proceedings and exception hearings, including:

- Responsibility of the the "written independent living transition proposal" for state wards who are also in the juvenile justice system;
- Creates a requirement for regular exception hearings as it relates to termination of parental rights proceedings;
- Allows for permanency preference for foster parents when a child has been there for more than 12 months if certain conditions are met;
- Adds language governing guardianship proceedings, including a standard of clear and convincing evidence when terminating such agreements.
