The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 886 would prohibit facilities providing health care services from advertising or holding itself out as being a network provider or accepting any health insurer unless the facility is a network provider of a health insurance plan. Additionally, the bill would prohibit any such facility from placing the name or logo of a health insurer in any signage or marketing materials if the facility is not a network provider.

Violation of the provisions of LB 886 would be considered a deceptive trade practice under the Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act and would make a contract entered into between a facility and a person covered by a health insurer voidable.
