The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB944 is proposed legislation that amends, revises, and harmonizes statutory provisions relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles. It allows for notice to the department when cities or villages pass new or amended annual motor vehicle fees; allows registration fee refunds resulting from natural disasters; harmonizes certain specialty plates to allow for temporary license stickers; allows for remote driver's license testing; allows for the issuance and delivery of a mobile driver's license; removes a mandatory requirement of the department to estimate liability under the International Fuel Tax Agreement Act (IFTAA), and removes an unnecessary requirement to submit an application for issuing replacements for apportionable vehicle license registrations. The bill will also harmonize provisions in statue when carriers are in violation of the Unified Carrier Registration Act (UCRA).
