- rates outside of the established rate structure can create barriers to 19

- 21 the state from accessing federal foster care funds that would otherwise
- 22 be available under Title IV-E of the federal Social Security Act, and (d)
- additional tiers of caregiving should be utilized to support the 23
- exceptional caregiving needs of children. 24
- (4) The Legislature further finds that (a) additional treatment 25
- services are needed to support the behavioral and mental health needs of 26
- youth who are at risk of entering, or who are stepping down from, 27
