- alcoholic liquor authorized under such license to a person twenty-one 10
- years of age or older within a motor vehicle if (a) the alcoholic liquor 11
- 12 is sold along with food, (b) the motor vehicle is in park, and (c) the
- alcoholic liquor is placed in the trunk of the motor vehicle or the area 13
- behind the last upright seat of such motor vehicle if the area is not 14
- normally occupied by the driver or a passenger and the motor vehicle is 15
- not equipped with a trunk. 16
- (b) A licensee which sells alcoholic liquor in the manner authorized 17
- under this section shall provide notice to the commission during initial 18
- 19 licensure or at the time of the licensee's annual renewal regarding such
- 20 sales.
- (3) This section shall not apply to sales to handicapped persons in 21
- a motor vehicle displaying a current handicapped license plate issued by 22
- the Department of Motor Vehicles. 23
