## NOTICE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO NEB. REV. STAT. § 58-270(3)

(Filed within 30 days following the issuance of Bonds)

The Nebraska Investment Finance Authority (the "Authority") hereby gives notice in accordance with the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 58-201 et seq., as amended (the "Act"), to the Honorable Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska (the "State"), and Patrick J. O'Donnell, Clerk of the Legislature, following the issuance by the Authority of the following bonds:

\$3,195,000 Nebraska Investment Finance Authority Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Bonds Series 2022A (the "Bonds")

The Bonds were issued by the Authority on August 25, 2022, and this Notice is being filed with the Governor of the State and the Clerk of the Legislature within 30 days following the issuance of the Bonds. A "Notice Required Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 58-270(2)" was filed with the Governor of the State and the Clerk of the Legislature on or about April 28, 2022.

For new loans, initially the combined annual interest rate and administrative fee will be 1%, as described in the Nebraska State Revolving Fund Clean Water & Drinking Water Intended Use Plan for State Fiscal Year 2023 (the "IUP"), and is subject to increase or adjustment as described in the IUP. For disbursements on existing loans, the interest rate and administrative fee will be as previously determined for those existing loans.

f) The amount of funds deposited into the State Match Loan Account for providing state match loan funds: \$3,195,000\*
