## **GENERAL FILE: 2021 PRIORITY BILLS - "Early Bird Division"**

- LB 14 (*Blood*) Adopt the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate Compact
- LB 387 (*Brewer, at the request of the Governor*) Change provisions relating to the taxation of military retirement benefits
- LB 400 (*Arch*) Change requirements related to coverage of telehealth by insurers and medicaid
- LB 389 (*Sanders, at the request of the Governor*) Require the issuance of teaching certificates and permits to military spouses
- LB 274 (*Lowe*) Provide for a promotional farmers market special designated license under the Nebraska Liquor Control Act

- LB 368 (*Sanders*) Provide the Auditor of Public Accounts enforcement powers for failure of political subdivisions to file reports

- LB 255 (*Hansen, M.*) Adopt the In the Line of Duty Compensation Act
- LB 407 (*McDonnell*) Include certain county correctional officers in provisions governing mental injuries and mental illnesses under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act
- LB 90 (*Halloran*) Change fee provisions under the Pesticide Act and the Nebraska Commercial Fertilizer and Soil Conditioner Act
- LB 91 (*Brandt*) Change germination seed testing provisions under the Nebraska Seed Law
- LB 92 (*Clements*) Change residency requirements for college tuition purposes for students from schools that elect not to meet accreditation or approval requirements
