Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 124 changes certain aspects of the Inspector General for Corrections reports. The bill changes the due date for the annual report from September 15 to October 15. In addition, the proposal includes an additional element in the report summarizing multi-year systemic issues.

Section 1 Amends 47-918 regarding Inspector General for Corrections reports, by moving the date of the annual report from September 15 to October 15. The bill also adds another element to the report, requiring a summary of multi-year systemic areas of concern, including related findings and recommendations.

Section 2 Repeals original section.
