Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB189 makes adjustments to the refunding of real or personal property taxes paid. If the county treasurer does not have sufficient funds to make the refund payment, the refund will be registered as a claim against the political subdivision. A receipt will be issued to the person entitled to the refund.

If a receipt is given, the governing body of the political subdivision shall make provisions in its next budget cycle to pay the refund; or, upon mutual agreement the receipt may be used to pay any taxes levied until the claim is satisfied in full.

Interest at the amount of 9% shall accrue on the unpaid balance of the refund. Interest will begin to accrue on the date of entry of the final non-appealable order or other action approving the refund.
