Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB1 changes district boundaries of the members of the Representatives in the Congress of the United States by the adoption of maps by reference.

The state is divided into three congressional districts. The overall range of deviation is approximately 0 percent.

The districts are drawn using census geography and population data from the 2020 US Census.

The maps are to be kept in the Secretary of State's Office.

The bill includes an emergency clause.
