Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would authorize the appointment of a county surveyor who resides within the county where the appointment is to occur. Under the current version of Section 23-1901.01, counties with fewer than 150,000 residents must either (a) elect a county surveyor who will reside in the county, or (2) if no qualified surveyor is elected who will reside in the county, appoint a qualified surveyor from outside the county. LB 224 would authorize the appointment of a qualified surveyor who resides in the county but did not seek election.
