## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 251 would amend the organ and tissue donation statute of the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act, and the Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act by changing the age for an un-emancipated minor to decide to become an organ or tissue donor from the age of sixteen to the age of fourteen. The fourteen year old applicant would indicate on their application for drivers license or state identification card that he or she would like to be a donor.
