Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill amends the plan review fee structure currently listed in statute and replaces it with a simplified fee structure allowing for more effective and efficient customer experience. Further, LB37 will amend the qualifications for the State Boiler Inspector in order to reflect the majority of states who have similar statutes. Lastly LB37 modernizes the regulations on LPG air conditioning units and outdated definitions for hotels and lodging houses while eliminating the standpipe requirement for hotels of a certain height.
