Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 385, introduced by the Speaker, at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations. This bill's primary purpose is to amend Nebraska Revised Statutes section 84-612 to provide for transfers from the Cash Reserve Fund. The bill includes transfers from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund in FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 and a transfer of \$50 million to the Governor%u2019s Emergency Program Fund in FY2021-22.

This bill contains the emergency clause.

Explanation of amendments:

The amendment strikes the provisions relating to transfers from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund. The amendment provides for a \$50 million transfer to the United State Space Command Headquarters Assistance Fund and directs that the transfer shall not occur unless the State of Nebraska is selected as the site of the United State Space Command Headquarters.
