Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 401 would amend statutes related to state institutions operated by the Department of Health and Human Services.

The bill would remove language stating 'the state hospital established in Adams County shall be known as the Hastings Regional Center' (Section 1, p. 2).

The bill would also clarify language designating the Hastings Regional Center as a state institution, but not necessarily a state hospital. (Section 2, p. 2).

The Hastings Regional Center would no longer be designated as a state hospital, though it would still remain a state institution under the jurisdiction of the Department of Health and Human Services.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 59 to LB 401 would remove any mention to the Hastings Regional Center in Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 83-363. The current bill states that the Hastings Regional Center is a state institution, but removes its status as a state hospital. The Hastings Regional Center is still currently listed as a state institution in Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 83-107.1.
