## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 407 extends workers' compensation coverage to high-population county correction officers who suffer mental injuries without a corresponding physical injury.

County correction officer is defined as a correctional officer employed by a county with more than 300,000 residents, whose duties involve maintaining order and custody of inmates in a county jail and has regular and direct contact with high-risk individuals.

High-risk individual is defined as an individual in custody for whom violent or physically intimidating behavior is common and a person in the custody of a county jail or in the process of being placed in the custody of a county jail in a high-population county.

Custody is defined as being under the control of a state institution or agency or county jail.
