## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB468 amends Section 37-201 to 37-811 and 37-1501 to 37-151 of the state Game Law and provides that the Game and Parks Commission shall compensate landowners for damage to farm crops, livestock, structures, fencing, and other property caused by game animals and game birds on an ongoing basis; directs the commission to make and adopt rules and regulations for reimbursing landowners for the damage and to include in those rules a provisions for assessment of damages by a third-party certified appraiser, inspector, or real estate appraiser agreed upon by the commission and the

landowner.
