Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would require that all petition signatures and associated documents be submitted together for verification at one time. Petition signatures would become invalid if not submitted to the Secretary of State by July 15th before a statewide general election. The bill would also increase from 10 days to 20 days the time authorized for the Secretary of State's signature verification after submission by the sponsor or sponsors. Finally, LB 514 would move up by two weeks the deadlines for filing the petition in order for the party to be included in a primary or general election.
