## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Senator Bostar introduced LB573, which amends Section 70-2002(7) (f) to specify that the rated capacity of a facility for purposes of qualifying as a facility for the production of electrical energy shall be measured in alternating current.

To participate as a customer-generator in a net metering relationship with a utility in Nebraska, the energy generating system must be determined to be a qualified facility. Qualifications of facilities are defined in Section 70-2002(7). Currently, one of the qualification is that the facility have "a rated capacity at or below twenty-five kilowatts."
