Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The bill addresses the documentation required to claim the 50% exclusion from income tax for military retirement benefits that commences with taxable years beginning or deemed to begin on or after January 1, 2022.

The bill clarifies that for purposes of claiming the exclusion, the taxpayer may attach either a 1099-R received from the United State Department of Defense or a 1099-R received from the United States Office of Personnel Management.
