Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 660 amends the State Employees Collective Bargaining Act to clarify that certain employees in the University System and certain employees at State Colleges are able to petition the Commission of Industrial Relations for certification of exclusive bargaining representatives within bargaining units that are based on the campus where those employees are employed.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment, AM120:

Restructures LB 660 to make the operative date of August 21, 2021 its own section (Sec 2).

Refers to all Nebraska universities and Nebraska state colleges as Nebraska state colleges.

Removes the language "Kearney State College" due to said college now being named University of Nebraska at Kearney.
