Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill eliminates an unfunded state mandate on counties requiring the filing of a monthly report to the Department of Health and Human Services relating to new marriages. This monthly county report is intended to confirm receipt of previously submitted individual certificates. However, the individual certificates are now transmitted electronically by the counties to DHHS. Due to the nature of these electronic submissions, automated confirmation of receipt is part of the initial submission process. This makes the monthly confirmation report redundant and obsolete.
