Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

Under this bill a local match could not be required for loan repayments for qualifying practitioners under the Rural Health Systems and Professional Incentive act if not required by federal law.

The current loan repayment program requires a local match equal to the amount of state funds provided to an eligible health or medical professional. The local match is paid to the Department of Health and Human Services. The department makes the loan repayment with the combined state and local match funding.

The bill as written would prohibit a local match if a match is not required under federal law. The prohibition applies to repayment of qualified educational debts under Section 2 of 71-5668. Section 2 includes the state loan repayment program which is not covered by any federal requirement. It's unclear if the intent is to only prohibit a local match on loan repayments under the federal program or all loan repayments. If the intent is for the restriction to only apply to federal loan repayments, revenue would decrease by \$450,000. As the bill is written, it would apply to all loan repayments, even the state only ones. The revenue reduction would be \$2.4 million.
