Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would provide for counting Nebraska residents in Nebraska prisons for redistricting purposes, and it has the emergency clause. It states that for purposes of drawing boundaries for legislative districts and congressional districts, an individual who was a resident of Nebraska prior to being confined to a prison in Nebraska shall be counted as a resident of the county, city, or village in which the individual was a resident prior to being confined.

It is the understanding of LFO that the Census Bureau will include a separate data set in official figures that states will use for redistricting purposes that includes counts of prisoners in their physical location and counts allocating them to their home districts.

Because this information is available, there should not be a fiscal impact to the state or political subdivisions.
