**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

This bill, as amended by AM1108 and FA39, would change provisions relating to appointment of counsel for juveniles.

The Supreme Court has contacted LFO and stated that LB307, as amended by AM1108 & FA39, would not change the fiscal note dated 1/25/21 on LB307 as introduced. In that fiscal note, the Supreme Court estimated a minimal fiscal impact to provide judicial branch education, case management modifications (JUSTICE), and to create court rules. They also estimate an unknown workload impact from these two amendments. See their fiscal note attached for additional details.

Additionally, AM1081 is similar to LB354, 2021. This bill would require county or district courts to issue decisions on motions to transfer jurisdiction in cases involving juveniles within thirty days after the hearing. The Supreme Court stated that LB354 could have a significant impact on court workload in certain jurisdictions. However, the financial impact of any workload change from this amendment cannot be determined at this time.

In summary, no additional resources are required for LB307, amended as of 4/28/21.
