**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

This bill would change permit and renewal time periods under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act. It would increase the renewal period from 5 to 10 years.

The renewal fee is \$50 and the fee revenue is deposited into the State Patrol Cash Fund. Expenditures related to administering the concealed carry program also come this cash fund. Because this bill doubles the length of time for renewal, fee revenues to the State Patrol Cash Fund could decrease. This could have an impact on the State Patrol's ability to administer the concealed carry program.

However, the State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

COMMENTS: Do not disagree with the Nebraska State Patrol estimate of No Fiscal Impact to the Agency from LB 404. While the bill does double the length of time for renewal for concealed handgun permits, therefore potentially reducing annual cash revenue to the Agency, it could also reduce the annual cost of processing applications, as they would be spread over a longer period of time.
