The Supreme Court estimates a minimal fiscal impact.

This bill has the potential to reduce time spent in jail because it increases the credit received against a jail term. If the impact of this bill is to decrease the number of people serving time in county jails by more than current law, this could result in a savings to counties.

Lancaster County Department of Corrections states that this bill may reduce the average length of stay in jail, but they cannot quantify the reduction.

However, a majority of individuals serving sentences and thus eligible for credit are also in custody on pre-trial cases. This makes it impossible for us to quantify the length of stay reduction.
