LB527 amends §83-1225 by changing the age from no later than sixteen to no later than fourteen years of age for students with a developmental disability with whom a school district provides transition services to.

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) estimates the need to hire an additional eight FTE's to cover the addition of fourteen and fifteen year olds to those being provided transition services. Those eight FTE's have a salary cost of \$563,448 for FY 2021-22 and \$585,978 for FY 2022-23. NDE also estimates the need for federal funds of \$150,000 for FY 2021-22 and \$300,000 for FY 2022-23 to implement and maintain case services.

COMMENTS: The fiscal note provided by the agency is confusing. The numbers listed under expenditures at the top does not match to the numbers listed in the breakdown at the bottom. It is unclear how federal funds are expected to be utilized. Will the federal funds be used as aid or will they be used to offset the cost of the VR Service Specialist? The breakdown provided in the Explanation area appears to be only for FY21-22.

The cost share between General Funds and federal funds appears to be different with how the program is currently funded and no explanation for this difference is included.

Disagree with the salary increase in FY22-23 estimated at about 4%. The agency has provided increases ranging from 1% to 3% over the last few years.
