Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 902 provides direct scholarship financial aid support for Nebraska residents pursuing degrees in high-demand careers in the University of Nebraska, State College, and Community College systems.

LB 902 codifies the career scholarship programs contained in the biennial budget bill, LB 380 (2021). As such, there is a current appropriation for these programs to the University, State Colleges, and Department of Economic Development (DED) for the current biennium. As originally drafted, LB 902 stated intent to appropriate certain dollar amounts for FY24 and FY25.

In AM 2194, this intent language was removed, as each agency will request appropriate general fund aid dollars during the next biennium budget request process.

AM 2194 also adds a \$50,000 general fund appropriation to the Board of Trustees for the Nebraska State College System for FY2022-23 to be used for cooperative programs with Wayne State College.
