- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations

  Act; to amend sections 81-1801, 81-1807, 81-1808, and 81-1815,

  Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to define terms; to provide for compensation for health care providers for costs incurred for examining or treating victims of sexual assault, domestic assault, or child abuse; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-1801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 81-1801 For purposes of the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations Act,
- 4 unless the context otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Child abuse means an offense under section 28-707;
- 6 (2) (1) Commission shall mean the Nebraska Commission on Law
- 7 Enforcement and Criminal Justice;
- 8 (3) (2) Committee shall mean the Crime Victim's Reparations
- 9 Committee;
- 10 (4) (3) Dependent shall mean a relative of a deceased victim who was
- 11 dependent upon the victim's income at the time of death, including a
- 12 child of a victim born after a victim's death;
- 13 (5) Domestic assault means an offense under section 28-323;
- 14 (6) (4) Executive director shall mean the executive director of the
- 15 commission;
- 16 (7) Health care provider means any person licensed or certified by
- 17 <u>the State of Nebraska to deliver health care under the Uniform</u>
- 18 Credentialing Act and any health care facility licensed under the Health
- 19 <u>Care Facility Licensure Act. Health care provider includes any</u>
- 20 professional corporation or other professional entity comprised of such
- 21 <u>health care providers;</u>
- 22 (8) (5) Personal injury shall mean actual bodily harm;
- 23 (9) (6) Relative shall mean spouse, parent, grandparent, stepparent,
- 24 natural born child, stepchild, adopted child, grandchild, brother,
- 25 sister, half brother, half sister, or spouse's parent;—and
- 26 (10) Sexual assault has the same meaning as in section 29-4309; and
- 27 (11) (7) Victim shall mean a person who is injured or killed as a
- 28 result of conduct specified in section 81-1818.
- 29 Sec. 2. Section 81-1807, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 30 amended to read:
- 31 81-1807 (1) Any person who may be eligible for compensation under

- 1 the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations Act may make application to the
- 2 committee on forms provided by the committee. If the person entitled to
- 3 make application is a minor or mentally incompetent, the application may
- 4 be made on his or her behalf by his or her parent, guardian, or any other
- 5 individual authorized to administer his or her estate. Residents and
- 6 nonresidents of Nebraska who are victims of crimes committed in Nebraska
- 7 shall be treated similarly in determining compensation awards under the
- 8 act. A resident of Nebraska who is the victim of a crime committed in
- 9 another state shall be eligible for compensation if (a) (1) the crime
- 10 would be compensable had it occurred in Nebraska and (b) (2) the crime
- 11 occurred in a state which does not have a crime victim compensation
- 12 program for which the person is eligible.
- 13 <u>(2)(a) Beginning on the effective date of this act, a health care</u>
- 14 provider may, with the permission of the victim, apply for reimbursement
- 15 for health care costs incurred by the provider that are otherwise to be
- 16 paid for by a victim of sexual assault, domestic assault, or child abuse
- 17 and for which the provider will not otherwise receive reimbursement from
- 18 private insurance, the medical assistance program established pursuant to
- 19 the Medical Assistance Act, the Sexual Assault Payment Program, or any
- 20 other entity, source, or fund, whether public or private.
- 21 (b) To be eligible for reimbursement under this section, such health
- 22 care costs must have been incurred by the health care provider in
- 23 treating or examining injuries of the victim arising out of the sexual
- 24 <u>assault</u>, <u>domestic assault</u>, <u>or child abuse</u>. The provider shall apply to
- 25 the committee on forms provided by the committee.
- Sec. 3. Section 81-1808, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 28 81-1808 In order to be eligible for compensation the applicant,
- 29 <u>including a health care provider as described in section 81-1807</u>, shall,
- 30 prior to any hearing on an application, submit available reports from any
- 31 physician or surgeon who has treated or examined the victim in relation

- 1 to the injury for which compensation is claimed at the time of or
- 2 subsequent to the victim's injury or death. If, in the opinion of the
- 3 hearing officer or the committee, reports on the previous medical history
- 4 of the victim, a report on the examination of the injured victim, or a
- 5 report on the cause of death of the victim by an impartial medical expert
- 6 would be of material aid to its determination, the hearing officer or the
- 7 committee shall order the reports and examination.
- 8 Sec. 4. Section 81-1815, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 81-1815 In a case in which a person is injured or killed as a result
- 11 of conduct specified in the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations Act, or
- 12 by any act of any other person which is within the description of
- 13 offenses listed in such act, the committee or a hearing officer may order
- 14 the payment of compensation:
- 15 (1) To or for the benefit of the injured person;
- 16 (2) In the case of personal injury or death of the victim, to a
- 17 person responsible for the maintenance of the victim who has suffered
- 18 pecuniary loss or incurred expenses as a result of the injury;—or
- 19 (3) In the case of death of the victim, to or for the benefit of any
- 20 one or more of the dependents of the victim; or -
- 21 <u>(4) To a health care provider for costs incurred in treating or</u>
- 22 examining injuries of the victim arising out of the sexual assault,
- 23 <u>domestic assault, or child abuse as described in section 81-1807.</u>
- 24 <u>Compensation paid to a victim shall not include such costs paid</u> to a
- 25 <u>health care provider</u>.
