- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to highways and roads; to amend sections
- 2 39-1365.01 and 39-1365.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 3 2020; to provide requirements for a report and a presentation by the
- 4 Department of Transportation; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. Section 39-1365.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 39-1365.01 The department shall be responsible for developing a
- 4 specific and long-range state highway system plan. The department shall
- 5 annually formulate plans to meet the state highway system needs of all
- 6 facets of the state and shall assign priorities for such needs. The
- 7 department shall, on or before December 1 of each year, present such
- 8 plans <u>and the report required in section 39-1365.02</u> to the Legislature.
- 9 The plans shall be referred to the appropriate standing committees of the
- 10 Legislature for review. The department shall consider the preservation of
- 11 the existing state highway system asset as its primary priority except as
- 12 may otherwise be provided in state or federal law. In establishing
- 13 secondary priorities, the department shall consider a variety of factors,
- 14 including, but not limited to, current and projected traffic volume,
- 15 safety requirements, economic development needs, current and projected
- 16 demographic trends, and enhancement of the quality of life for all
- 17 Nebraska citizens. The state highway system plan shall include the
- 18 designation of those portions of the state highway system which shall be
- 19 expressways.
- Sec. 2. Section 39-1365.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 21 2020, is amended to read:
- 22 39-1365.02 (1) The department shall apply for and make maximum use
- 23 of available federal funding, including discretionary funding, on all
- 24 highway construction projects which are eligible for such assistance.
- 25 (2) The department shall transmit electronically to the Legislature,
- 26 by December 1 of each year, a report on the needs of the state highway
- 27 system, the department's planning procedures, and the progress being made
- on the expressway system. Such report shall include:
- (a) The criteria by which highway needs are determined;
- 30 (b) The standards established for each classification of highways;
- 31 (c) An assessment of current and projected needs of the state

- 1 highway system, such needs to be defined by category of improvement
- 2 required to bring each segment up to standards. Projected fund
- 3 availability shall not be a consideration by which needs are determined;
- 4 (d) Criteria and data, including factors enumerated in section
- 5 39-1365.01, upon which decisions may be made on possible special priority
- 6 highways for commercial growth;
- 7 (e) A review of the department's procedure for selection of projects
- 8 for the annual construction program, the five-year planning program, and
- 9 extended planning programs. The review shall include a statement of all
- 10 state highway projects under construction, other than any part of the
- 11 expressway system, and the estimated cost of each project;
- 12 (f) A review of the progress being made toward completion of the
- 13 expressway system, as such system was designated on January 1, 2016, and
- 14 whether such work is on pace for completion prior to June 30, 2033. The
- 15 review shall include a statement of the amount of money spent on the
- 16 expressway system, as of the date of the report, and the number of miles
- of the expressway system yet to be completed and expected milestone dates
- 18 for other expressway projects, including planning, permitting, designing,
- 19 <u>bid letting</u>, and required funding for project completion;
- 20 (g) A review of the Transportation Infrastructure Bank Fund and the
- 21 fund's component programs under sections 39-2803 to 39-2807. This review
- 22 shall include a listing of projects funded and planned to be funded under
- 23 each of the three component programs; and
- 24 (h) A review of the outcomes of the Economic Opportunity Program,
- 25 including the growth in permanent jobs and related income and the net
- 26 increase in overall business activity.
- 27 Sec. 3. Original sections 39-1365.01 and 39-1365.02, Revised
- 28 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, are repealed.
