- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Dentistry Practice Act; to amend
- 2 section 38-1124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to faculty licenses; to define terms; to repeal
- 4 the original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 38-1124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

2 amended to read:

- 3 38-1124 (1) The department, with the recommendation of the board, 4 shall issue a faculty license to any person who meets the requirements of 5 subsection (3) or (4) of this section. A faculty licensee may practice dentistry only as a faculty member at an accredited school or college of 6 dentistry in the State of Nebraska. A faculty licensee and may also teach 7 dentistry, conduct research, and participate in an institutionally 8 9 administered faculty practice—only at such accredited school or college 10 of dentistry. A faculty licensee eligible for licensure under subsection (4) of this section shall limit his or her practice under such license to 11 the clinical <u>disciplines</u> discipline in which the <u>licensee</u> he or she has 12 13 received postgraduate education at an accredited school or college of dentistry or, with the approval of the board, the clinical disciplines in 14 which the licensee has practiced under a license, including a faculty 15 license or teaching permit, to practice dentistry within the past three 16 years in another jurisdiction. 17
- (2) Any person who desires a faculty license shall make a written 18 application to the department. The application shall include information 19 regarding the applicant's professional qualifications, experience, and 20 licensure. The application shall be accompanied by a copy of the 21 22 applicant's dental degree, any other degrees or certificates 23 postgraduate education of the applicant, the required fee, and 24 certification from the dean of an accredited school or college of 25 dentistry in the State of Nebraska at which the applicant has a contract to be employed as a full-time faculty member. 26
- 27 (3) An individual who graduated from an accredited school or college 28 of dentistry shall be eligible for a faculty license if <u>the individual</u> he 29 or she:
- 30 (a) Has or had a license<u>, including a faculty license or teaching</u> 31 <u>permit</u>, to practice dentistry within the past <u>three</u> five years in <u>another</u>

- 1 jurisdiction some other state in the United States or a Canadian
- 2 province; and
- 3 (b) Has a contract to be employed as a full-time faculty member at
- 4 an accredited school or college of dentistry in the State of Nebraska;
- (b) (c) Passes a jurisprudence examination administered by the
- 6 board. ; and
- 7 (d) Agrees to demonstrate continuing clinical competency as a
- 8 condition of licensure if required by the board.
- 9 (4) An individual who graduated from a nonaccredited school or
- 10 college of dentistry shall be eligible for a faculty license if <u>the</u>
- 11 <u>individual</u> he or she:
- 12 (a)(i) Has or had a license, including a faculty license or teaching
- 13 permit, to practice dentistry within the past three years in another
- 14 jurisdiction;
- 15 <u>(ii)</u> (a) Has completed at least two years of postgraduate education
- 16 at an accredited school or college of dentistry recognized by the
- 17 <u>national commission</u> and received a certificate or degree from such school
- 18 or college of dentistry; or
- 19 <u>(iii) Has additional education in dentistry at an accredited school</u>
- 20 or college of dentistry that is determined by the board to be equivalent
- 21 to a program recognized by the national commission, including, but not
- 22 limited to, a postgraduate certificate or degree in operative dentistry;
- 23 (b) Has a contract to be employed as a full-time faculty member at
- 24 an accredited school or college of dentistry in the State of Nebraska;
- 25 (b) (c) Passes a jurisprudence examination administered by the
- 26 board; and
- 27 (d) Agrees to demonstrate continuing clinical competency as a
- 28 condition of licensure if required by the board; and
- 29 <u>(c) (e)</u> Has passed <u>at least one of the following:</u>
- 30 <u>(i) Part I and Part II of the National Board Dental Examinations</u>
- 31 administered by the joint commission; or its equivalent

1 (ii) The Integrated National Board Dental Examination administered

- 2 by the joint commission;
- 3 (iii) A specialty board examination recognized by the national
- 4 commission;
- 5 (iv) An examination administered by the National Dental Examining
- 6 Board of Canada; or
- 7 (v) An equivalent examination as determined by the Board of
- 8 Dentistry.
- 9 (5) A faculty license shall expire at the same time and be subject
- 10 to the same renewal requirements as a regular dental license, except that
- 11 such license shall remain valid and may only be renewed if the faculty
- 12 <u>licensee completes continuing education as required by the rules and</u>
- 13 regulations adopted and promulgated under the Dentistry Practice Act and
- 14 <u>demonstrates continued employment at an accredited school or college of</u>
- 15 dentistry in the State of Nebraska. ÷
- 16 (6) In order for an applicant to qualify for a faculty license
- 17 pursuant to subdivision (4)(a)(iii) of this section, the applicant shall
- 18 present, for review and approval by the board, a portfolio which
- 19 includes, but is not limited to, academic achievements, credentials and
- 20 <u>certifications, letters of recommendation, and a list of publications.</u>
- 21 <u>(7) For purposes of this section:</u>
- 22 (a) Another jurisdiction means some other state in the United
- 23 States, a territory or jurisdiction of the United States, or a Canadian
- 24 province;
- 25 (b) Joint commission means the American Dental Association Joint
- 26 <u>Commission on National Dental Examinations; and</u>
- 27 <u>(c) National commission means the National Commission on Recognition</u>
- 28 of Dental Specialties and Certifying Boards.
- 29 (a) The faculty licensee remains employed as a full-time faculty
- 30 member of an accredited school or college of dentistry in the State of
- 31 Nebraska; and
