- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to railroad safety; to amend sections 74-1317,
- 2 74-1318, 75-401, 75-402, and 75-405, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska, and section 75-109.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 4 Supplement, 2020; to change provisions relating to the purpose of
- 5 the Grade Crossing Protection Fund; to provide for fund transfers as
- 6 prescribed; to provide duties; to create a fund; to harmonize
- 7 provisions; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an
- 8 emergency.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 74-1317, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 74-1317 In order to promote public safety at the intersection of
- 4 railroad lines and all classes of highways, there is hereby created a
- 5 special fund known as the Grade Crossing Protection Fund which shall be
- 6 established in the state treasury to be used in furnishing financial
- 7 assistance (1) in the improvement of the safety of railroad grade
- 8 crossings in this state, including the elimination of such crossings, (2)
- 9 <u>in</u> the construction, substantial modification, or improvement of and the
- 10 maintenance of automatic crossing protection at railroad such grade
- 11 crossings in this state, (3) in and the construction and maintenance of
- 12 overpasses and underpasses at railroad crossings in this state, and (4)
- 13 to the Public Service Commission to enforce railroad safety standards
- 14 pursuant to section 75-401. Transfers may be made from the fund as
- 15 provided under section 74-1318. Any money in the fund available for
- 16 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 17 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 18 Investment Act.
- 19 Sec. 2. Section 74-1318, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 74-1318 The department is hereby empowered to administer the funds
- 22 deposited in the Grade Crossing Protection Fund as follows:
- 23 (1) If the department and the political subdivision with
- 24 jurisdiction over the crossing agree that a grade crossing should be
- 25 eliminated by closing the street, road, or highway, the political
- 26 subdivision making such closing shall receive five thousand dollars from
- 27 the fund and five thousand dollars from the railroad involved and the
- 28 actual cost of closure not to exceed twelve thousand dollars from the
- 29 fund. If pursuant to section 74-1305 it is agreed by the department and
- 30 the political subdivision that such crossing should be eliminated by the
- 31 removal of such rail line, the political subdivision paying for such

1 removal, if any, shall receive two thousand dollars or the actual cost

- 2 thereof not to exceed twelve thousand dollars from the fund;
- 3 (2) Except as otherwise provided in section 74-1315, in order to
- 4 facilitate and protect the interest of the public as a whole and to
- 5 compensate for the statewide use of such crossings by the public, the
- 6 department shall pay ninety-five percent of the cost of overpasses,
- 7 underpasses, and automatic railroad grade crossing protection measures or
- 8 devices from the fund for all such projects in which an agreement among
- 9 the department, the railroad, and the political subdivision is executed
- on or after May 24, 1979, and the balance of the cost shall be borne by
- 11 the political subdivision, except that in any county in which a railroad
- 12 transportation safety district has been formed, such balance shall be
- 13 borne entirely by the political subdivision. For all such projects in
- 14 which an agreement among the department, the railroad, and the political
- 15 subdivision was executed prior to May 24, 1979, the costs shall continue
- 16 to be borne in the same manner as they were prior to such date;
- 17 (3) It shall be the sole responsibility of the railroad company
- 18 involved to maintain all automatic railroad grade crossing protection
- 19 devices existing in this state;
- 20 (4) The department shall allocate the amount to be borne by the fund
- 21 for the cost of construction, installation, or substantial modification
- 22 or improvement of the automatic devices for the protection of the
- 23 railroad grade crossing concerned under this section and subdivisions
- 24 <u>(1), (2), and (3) of section 74-1317; and</u>
- 25 (5) The department shall enter into and enforce agreements involving
- 26 the fund and the supervision of the construction, installation,
- 27 substantial modification or improvement, and maintenance of such
- 28 overpasses, underpasses, and automatic safety devices for which any part
- 29 of the cost is borne from the fund and the auditing and collection of the
- 30 bills covering the cost thereof. The department is further authorized to
- 31 enter into such contracts with any railroad companies and political

- 1 subdivisions affected which are necessary to carry out this section and
- 2 <u>subdivisions (1), (2), and (3) of section 74-1317; and</u> -
- 3 (6) On or before July 1, 2021, and on or before each July 1
- 4 <u>thereafter</u>, the State Treasurer shall annually transfer one hundred
- 5 <u>twenty-five thousand dollars from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund to</u>
- 6 the Railroad Safety Cash Fund.
- 7 Sec. 3. Section 75-109.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 8 2020, is amended to read:
- 9 75-109.01 Except as otherwise specifically provided by law, the
- 10 Public Service Commission shall have jurisdiction, as prescribed, over
- 11 the following subjects:
- 12 (1) Common carriers, generally, pursuant to sections 75-101 to
- 13 75-158;
- 14 (2) Grain pursuant to the Grain Dealer Act and the Grain Warehouse
- 15 Act and sections 89-1,104 to 89-1,108;
- 16 (3) Manufactured homes and recreational vehicles pursuant to the
- 17 Uniform Standard Code for Manufactured Homes and Recreational Vehicles;
- 18 (4) Modular housing units pursuant to the Nebraska Uniform Standards
- 19 for Modular Housing Units Act;
- 20 (5) Motor carrier registration, licensure, and safety pursuant to
- 21 sections 75-301 to 75-343, 75-369.03, 75-370, and 75-371;
- 22 (6) Pipeline carriers and rights-of-way pursuant to the Major Oil
- 23 Pipeline Siting Act, the State Natural Gas Regulation Act, and sections
- 24 75-501 to 75-503. If the provisions of Chapter 75 are inconsistent with
- 25 the provisions of the Major Oil Pipeline Siting Act, the provisions of
- 26 the Major Oil Pipeline Siting Act control;
- 27 (7) Railroad carrier safety pursuant to sections 74-918, 74-919,
- 28 74-1323, and 75-401 to 75-430 and section 7 of this act;
- 29 (8) Telecommunications carriers pursuant to the Automatic Dialing-
- 30 Announcing Devices Act, the Emergency Telephone Communications Systems
- 31 Act, the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act, the Intrastate Pay-Per-Call

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Regulation Act, the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation Act, 1 the

- 2 Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act, the
- Telecommunications Relay System Act, the Telephone Consumer Slamming 3
- 4 Prevention Act, and sections 86-574 to 86-579;
- 5 (9) Transmission lines and rights-of-way pursuant to sections 70-301
- and 75-702 to 75-724; 6
- 7 (10) Water service pursuant to the Water Service Regulation Act; and
- (11) Jurisdictional utilities governed by the State Natural Gas 8
- 9 Regulation Act. If the provisions of Chapter 75 are inconsistent with the
- 10 provisions of the State Natural Gas Regulation Act, the provisions of the
- State Natural Gas Regulation Act control. 11
- Sec. 4. Section 75-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 12
- 13 amended to read:
- (1) The commission shall exercise jurisdiction over the 14 75-401
- service, facilities, and equipment of all railroad carriers in this 15
- state. This jurisdiction shall extend and apply to the general public, as 16
- well as those having business relations with the railroad carrier. 17
- Sections 75-401 to 75-430 and section 7 of this act shall not be 18
- construed as giving the commission jurisdiction or control over the 19
- relations between any railroad carrier and its employees, or 20
- employees' order, union, or other bargaining agent, either contractual or 21
- 22 otherwise, except as provided in sections 75-419 to 75-426.
- (2) The commission shall enforce the standards of railroad safety 23
- 24 set forth in 49 C.F.R. parts 213, 215, 223, 229, 231, and 232. Such
- 25 enforcement shall be carried out with financial assistance from the Grade
- Crossing Protection Fund as provided by section 74-1318. 26
- Sec. 5. Section 75-402, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 27
- amended to read: 28
- 75-402 As used in sections 75-401 to 75-430 and section 7 of this 29
- act, and in all rules and regulations prescribed by the commission, 30
- unless the context otherwise requires: 31

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- 1 (1) Commission means the Public Service Commission;
- 2 (2) Railroad means any line of railroad track, or part thereof,
- 3 located within the State of Nebraska; and
- 4 (3) (1) Railroad carrier means shall mean any common carrier engaged
- 5 in the carrying of freight or passengers over any line of railroad, or
- 6 part thereof, within the State of Nebraska. ; and
- 7 (2) Railroad shall mean any line of railroad track, or part thereof,
- 8 located within the State of Nebraska.
- 9 Sec. 6. Section 75-405, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 10 amended to read:
- 11 75-405 Every railroad carrier which operates lines within this state
- 12 shall make an annual agreement with each shipper that receives or sends
- 13 ten or more cars annually which provides the terms under which reciprocal
- 14 demurrage charges shall be made on the part of the railroad carrier or
- 15 shipper. Such terms shall be equal for all shippers. Any agreement made
- 16 under this section shall control the relation between the parties
- 17 thereto, the provisions of sections 75-401 to 75-430 and section 7 of
- 18 <u>this act</u> to the contrary notwithstanding. Monthly settlements may be
- 19 entered into, but all credits due a shipper for the current month shall
- 20 be carried to the shipper's credit for the succeeding month, except that
- 21 at the termination of the agreement, any credits due the shipper shall be
- 22 eliminated.
- 23 Sec. 7. The Railroad Safety Cash Fund is created. The fund shall be
- 24 used to support the commission in enforcing railroad safety standards
- 25 pursuant to section 75-401. The fund shall consist of transfers to the
- 26 <u>fund from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund as directed by the</u>
- 27 <u>Legislature</u>. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
- 28 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital
- 29 Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 30 Sec. 8. Original sections 74-1317, 74-1318, 75-401, 75-402, and
- 31 75-405, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 75-109.01,

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- 1 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, are repealed.
- 2 Sec. 9. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when

3 passed and approved according to law.
