- 4 a term; to change provisions relating to a microdistillery license;
- to repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.

1 Section 1. Section 53-103.22, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 3 53-103.22 Microdistillery means a distillery located in Nebraska
- 4 that is licensed to distill liquor on the premises of the distillery
- 5 licensee and produces one hundred ten thousand or fewer gallons of liquor
- 6 annually.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 53-123.16, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2020, is amended to read: 8 9 53-123.16 Any person who operates a microdistillery shall obtain a license pursuant to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act. A license to operate 10 a microdistillery shall permit the licensee to produce on the premises a 11 maximum of one hundred ten thousand gallons of liquor per year. A 12 microdistillery may also sell to licensed wholesalers for sale and 13 distribution to licensed retailers. A microdistillery shall not sell its 14 microdistilled product directly to another Nebraska retail license. A 15 microdistillery license issued pursuant to this section shall be the only 16
- 17 license required by the Nebraska Liquor Control Act for the manufacture
- and retail sale of microdistilled product for consumption on or off the
- 19 licensed premises, except that the sale of any beer, wine, or alcoholic
- 20 liquor, other than microdistilled product manufactured by the
- 21 microdistillery licensee, by the drink for consumption on the
- 22 microdistillery premises shall require the appropriate retail license.
- 23 Any license held by the operator of a microdistillery shall be subject to
- 24 the act. A holder of a microdistillery license may obtain an annual
- 25 catering license pursuant to section 53-124.12, a special designated
- 26 license pursuant to section 53-124.11, or an entertainment district
- 27 license pursuant to section 53-123.17. The commission may, upon the
- 28 conditions it determines, grant to any microdistillery licensed under
- 29 this section a special license authorizing the microdistillery to
- 30 purchase and to import, from such persons as are entitled to sell the
- 31 same, wines or spirits to be used solely as ingredients and for the sole

- 2 of the microdistillation process.
- 3 Sec. 3. Original section 53-103.22, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, and section 53-123.16, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 5 2020, are repealed.
- 6 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 7 passed and approved according to law.
