- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to game and parks; to amend sections 37-435,
- 2 37-437, 37-439, and 37-446, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- and section 37-438, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to
- 4 define and redefine terms; to provide for regular and limited annual
- 5 and temporary park entry permits as prescribed; to change and
- 6 provide fees; to provide for designation and disbursement of certain
- 7 fees under the State Park Cash Revolving Fund; to harmonize
- 8 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-435, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 37-435 For purposes of sections 37-434 to 37-446, unless the context
- 4 otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Limited permit means a permit granting access to all permit
- 6 areas except Lake McConaughy State Recreation Area and Lake Ogallala
- 7 State Recreation Area;
- 8 (2) (1) Motor vehicle means any self-propelled vehicle of a type
- 9 required to be registered and licensed for operation on the highways of
- 10 the state;
- 11 (3) Nonresident motor vehicle means a motor vehicle registered or
- 12 <u>licensed in another state;</u>
- 13 (4) Permit areas means those areas, or portions of areas, of the
- 14 Nebraska state park system which are defined in subdivisions (1), (2),
- 15 and (3) of section 37-338 and which are designated as provided in
- 16 sections 37-339 and 37-340;
- 17 (5) Permit means any motor vehicle entry permit issued under section
- 18 37-438 or 37-439;
- 19 <u>(6) Regular permit means a permit granting access to all permit</u>
- 20 <u>areas; and</u>
- 21 (7) Resident motor vehicle means a motor vehicle registered and
- 22 <u>licensed in this state.</u>
- 23 (2) Permit areas means those areas, or portions of areas, of the
- 24 Nebraska state park system which are defined in subdivisions (1), (2),
- 25 and (3) of section 37-338 and which are designated as provided in
- 26 sections 37-339 and 37-340; and
- 27 (3) Permit means motor vehicle entry permit.
- 28 Sec. 2. Section 37-437, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 29 amended to read:
- 30 37-437 A permit shall entitle the vehicle for which it is issued
- 31 access to any permit area authorized under such permit and no other right

- 1 or privilege shall be conveyed. A permit shall not entitle the holder, or
- 2 any occupant of the vehicle, to any service, facility, or activity for
- 3 which a separate fee is imposed.
- 4 Sec. 3. Section 37-438, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 5 2020, is amended to read:
- 6 37-438 (1) The commission shall devise annual, temporary, and
- 7 disabled veteran permits. Annual and temporary permits shall include
- 8 <u>regular permits and limited permits issued for a nonresident motor</u>
- 9 vehicle.
- 10 (2) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and shall be
- 11 valid through December 31 in the year for which the permit is issued. The
- 12 fee for the annual permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more
- 13 than thirty-five dollars per permit. The fee for the annual <u>limited</u>
- 14 permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall not be less than the fee for
- 15 a resident motor vehicle and not more than sixty-five dollars. The fee
- 16 for the annual regular permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall be
- 17 <u>eighty dollars. Except for the annual regular permit fee for a</u>
- 18 nonresident motor vehicle, the <del>The</del> commission shall establish such other
- 19 fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations. Except
- 20 for an annual limited permit, the commission may issue annual permits
- 21 which are valid for any area or combination of areas or valid for a
- 22 single area.
- 23 (3) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and shall be
- 24 valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The fee for the
- 25 temporary permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more than
- 26 seven dollars. The fee for the temporary limited permit for a nonresident
- 27 motor vehicle shall be not more than twelve dollars. The fee for the
- 28 <u>temporary regular permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall be fifteen</u>
- 29 <u>dollars. Except for the temporary regular permit fee for a nonresident</u>
- 30 <u>motor vehicle, the The</u> commission shall establish such <u>other</u> fees by the
- 31 adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations. Except for a

- 1 temporary limited permit, the The commission may issue temporary permits
- 2 which are either valid for any area or combination of areas or valid for
- 3 a single area.
- 4 (4)(a) A veteran who is a resident of Nebraska shall, upon
- 5 application and without payment of any fee, be issued one disabled
- 6 veteran permit for a resident motor vehicle if the veteran:
- 7 (i) Was discharged or separated with a characterization of honorable
- 8 or general (under honorable conditions); and
- 9 (ii)(A) Is rated by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- 10 as fifty percent or more disabled as a result of service in the armed
- 11 forces of the United States; or
- 12 (B) Is receiving a pension from the United States Department of
- 13 Veterans Affairs as a result of total and permanent disability, which
- 14 disability was not incurred in the line of duty in the military service.
- 15 (b) All disabled veteran permits issued pursuant to this subsection
- 16 shall be perpetual and shall become void only upon termination of
- 17 eligibility as provided in this subsection.
- 18 (c) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 19 necessary to carry out this subsection.
- 20 (5) The commission may offer permits or combinations of permits at
- 21 temporarily reduced rates for specific events or during specified
- 22 timeframes.
- 23 Sec. 4. Section 37-439, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 24 amended to read:
- 25 37-439 (1) In addition to the permits authorized in section 37-438,
- 26 the commission shall design a duplicate annual permit which may be
- 27 purchased for one-half the fee for of an annual permit\_prescribed in such
- 28 <u>section</u>.
- 29 (2) The registered owner of two or more motor vehicles may purchase
- 30 one duplicate annual permit for each annual permit purchased. The
- 31 duplicate annual permit shall be used for the purchaser's vehicles. A

1 duplicate annual permit may be purchased at any time during the year upon

- 2 proof of purchase of an annual permit and in compliance with rules and
- 3 regulations of the commission. A permitholder who sells his or her
- 4 vehicle may purchase a duplicate annual permit upon surrendering the
- 5 original permit or a substantial portion of the permit.
- 6 Sec. 5. Section 37-446, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 7 amended to read:
- 8 37-446 (1) The permit fees charged under sections 37-438 and 37-439
- 9 shall be credited to the State Park Cash Revolving Fund and, except as
- 10 specifically provided in subsection (2) of this section, shall be
- 11 disbursed for the administration, improvement, operation, and maintenance
- of those areas, or portion of areas, of the state park system which are
- 13 designated as permit areas.
- 14 (2) Not less than ninety-five percent of the difference between (a)
- 15 the amount of the fee charged for an annual limited permit for a
- 16 nonresident motor vehicle and the amount of the fee charged for an annual
- 17 regular permit for a nonresident motor vehicle and (b) the amount of the
- 18 <u>fee charged for a temporary limited permit for a nonresident motor</u>
- 19 vehicle and the amount of the fee charged for a temporary regular permit
- 20 for a nonresident motor vehicle shall be designated for use to help
- 21 defray operational, maintenance, and improvement costs at Lake McConaughy
- 22 State Recreation Area and Lake Ogallala State Recreation Area.

- 24 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 37-438, Revised
- 25 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, are repealed.
