1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-301 2 and 60-2907, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to 3 prohibit certain causes of action by motorists without insurance or 4 financial responsibility or motorists convicted of driving under the influence or refusal to test; to require the Department of Motor 5 6 Vehicles to establish and maintain an online verification system for 7 accessing certain private passenger motor vehicle insurance 8 information; to authorize a disclosure under the Uniform Motor 9 Vehicle Records Disclosure Act; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) On and after the effective date of this act, any
- 2 person who, at the time of an automobile accident resulting in injuries
- 3 to that person, is operating a motor vehicle without insurance or other
- 4 financial responsibility in violation of section 60-3,167, shall have no
- 5 cause of action for recovery of noneconomic damages sustained as a result
- 6 of such accident. This section does not apply and a cause of action for
- 7 noneconomic damages may be maintained if a court finds, by clear and
- 8 convincing evidence, that the person bringing the cause of action did not
- 9 knowingly at the time of the accident operate a motor vehicle that was in
- 10 violation of section 60-3,167. This section does not apply to any person
- 11 who at the time of an automobile accident has failed to maintain such
- 12 <u>insurance or other financial responsibility for a period of forty-five</u>
- 13 <u>days or less and who had complied with the act for at least one year</u>
- 14 <u>immediately prior to operating a motor vehicle in violation of the act.</u>
- 15 (2) On and after the effective date of this act, any person who is
- 16 <u>convicted of, or pleads guilty to, a violation of section 60-6,196 or</u>
- 17 <u>60-6,197 or a similar violation of law in another state or an ordinance</u>
- 18 of any city in connection with an accident shall have no cause of action
- 19 <u>for recovery of noneconomic damages sustained as a result of such</u>
- 20 <u>accident.</u>
- 21 (3) For purposes of this section, noneconomic damages means
- 22 subjective, nonmonetary losses, including, but not limited to, pain,
- 23 <u>suffering</u>, <u>inconvenience</u>, <u>mental suffering</u>, <u>emotional distress</u>, <u>loss of</u>
- 24 society and companionship, loss of consortium, injury to reputation, and
- 25 <u>humiliation</u>, but does not include economic damages.
- Sec. 2. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 27 2020, is amended to read:
- 28 60-301 Sections 60-301 to 60-3,254 <u>and section 3 of this act shall</u>
- 29 be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Registration Act.
- 30 Sec. 3. (1) The department, using the motor vehicle insurance data
- 31 base created in section 60-3,136, shall establish and maintain an online

- 2 <u>insurance or financial responsibility information required for motor</u>
- 3 <u>vehicles under section 60-3,167.</u>
- 4 (2) The online verification system shall be accessible through the
- 5 Internet or a similar proprietary or common carrier electronic system by
- 6 authorized personnel of the department, the courts, law enforcement
- 7 personnel, any other entities authorized by the department, and insurers
- 8 authorized by the Department of Insurance to issue the insurance or other
- 9 financial responsibility required by section 60-3,167.
- 10 (3) The online verification system shall be available twenty-four
- 11 hours per day seven days per week to verify the insurance status of any
- 12 motor vehicle registered for private use in this state through the
- 13 <u>vehicle's identification number, motor vehicle insurance policy number,</u>
- 14 <u>registered owner's name, or other identifying characteristic or marker as</u>
- 15 prescribed by the Department of Motor Vehicles in rules and regulations.
- 16 <u>(4) The online verification system shall be installed and</u>
- 17 <u>operational on an implementation date designated by the director, but no</u>
- 18 later than July 1, 2025, following an appropriate testing period.
- 19 (5) The department may contract with a private vendor to assist in
- 20 <u>establishing and maintaining the online verification system, which may</u>
- 21 include a data base of information reported to the department by insurers
- 22 or may provide for direct inquiry of insurers' records by authorized
- 23 personnel of the department.
- 24 (6) An insurer authorized to issue a private passenger motor vehicle
- 25 insurance policy in this state shall cooperate with the department in
- 26 establishing and maintaining the verification system and shall provide
- 27 <u>access to motor vehicle insurance policy status information for every</u>
- 28 motor vehicle insured by the insurer in this state.
- 29 (7) Each insurer shall, at the end of each business day, submit to
- 30 the department a record of each private passenger motor vehicle insurance
- 31 policy in effect for motor vehicles registered or garaged in this state

- 1 as of the date of such submission.
- 2 (8) The verification system shall include appropriate provisions,
- 3 consistent with industry standards, to secure its data against
- 4 unauthorized access and to maintain a record of all information requests.
- 5 Sec. 4. Section 60-2907, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 6 2020, is amended to read:
- 7 60-2907 The department and any officer, employee, agent, or
- 8 contractor of the department having custody of a motor vehicle record
- 9 shall, upon the verification of identity and purpose of a requester,
- 10 disclose and make available the requested motor vehicle record, including
- 11 the personal information in the record, for the following purposes:
- 12 (1) For use by any federal, state, or local governmental agency,
- 13 including any court or law enforcement agency, in carrying out the
- 14 agency's functions or by a private person or entity acting on behalf of a
- 15 governmental agency in carrying out the agency's functions;
- 16 (2) For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver
- 17 safety and theft; motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle product
- 18 alterations, recalls, or advisories; performance monitoring of motor
- 19 vehicles, motor vehicle parts, and dealers; motor vehicle market research
- 20 activities, including survey research; and removal of nonowner records
- 21 from the original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers;
- 22 (3) For use in the normal course of business by a legitimate
- 23 business or its agents, employees, or contractors but only:
- 24 (a) To verify the accuracy of personal information submitted by the
- 25 individual to the business or its agents, employees, or contractors; and
- 26 (b) If such information as so submitted is not correct or is no
- 27 longer correct, to obtain the correct information, but only for the
- 28 purposes of preventing fraud by, pursuing legal remedies against, or
- 29 recovering on a debt or security interest against, the individual;
- 30 (4) For use in connection with any civil, criminal, administrative,
- 31 or arbitral proceeding in any federal, state, or local court or

- 1 governmental agency or before any self-regulatory body, including service
- 2 of process, investigation in anticipation of litigation, and execution or
- 3 enforcement of judgments and orders, or pursuant to an order of a
- 4 federal, state, or local court, an administrative agency, or a self-
- 5 regulatory body;
- 6 (5) For use in research activities, and for use in producing
- 7 statistical reports, so long as the personal information is not
- 8 published, redisclosed, or used to contact individuals;
- 9 (6) For use by any insurer or insurance support organization, or by
- 10 a self-insured entity, or its agents, employees, or contractors, in
- 11 connection with claims investigation activities, anti-fraud activities,
- 12 rating, or underwriting, or to carry out the purposes of the online
- 13 <u>verification system under section 3 of this act;</u>
- 14 (7) For use in providing notice to the owners of abandoned, towed,
- 15 or impounded vehicles;
- 16 (8) For use only for a purpose permitted under this section either
- 17 by a private detective, plain clothes investigator, or private
- 18 investigative agency licensed under sections 71-3201 to 71-3213;
- 19 (9) For use by an employer or the employer's agent or insurer to
- 20 obtain or verify information relating to a holder of a commercial
- 21 driver's license or CLP-commercial learner's permit that is required
- 22 under the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986, 49 U.S.C. 31301 et
- 23 seq., or pursuant to sections 60-4,132 and 60-4,141;
- 24 (10) For use in connection with the operation of private toll
- 25 transportation facilities;
- 26 (11) For bulk distribution for surveys of, marketing to, or
- 27 solicitations of persons who have expressly consented to such disclosure
- 28 if the requester has obtained the notarized written consent of the
- 29 individual who is the subject of the personal information being requested
- 30 and has provided proof of receipt of such written consent to the
- 31 department or an officer, employee, agent, or contractor of the

- department on a form prescribed by the department;
- 2 (12) For any use if the requester has obtained the notarized written
- 3 consent of the individual who is the subject of the personal information
- 4 being requested and has provided proof of receipt of such written consent
- 5 to the department or an officer, employee, agent, or contractor of the
- 6 department;
- 7 (13) For use, including redisclosure through news publication, of a
- 8 member of a medium of communication as defined in section 20-145 who
- 9 requests such information in connection with preparing, researching,
- 10 gathering, or confirming news information involving motor vehicle or
- 11 driver safety or motor vehicle theft;
- 12 (14) For use by the federally designated organ procurement
- 13 organization for Nebraska to establish and maintain the Donor Registry of
- 14 Nebraska as provided in section 71-4822;
- 15 (15) For use to fulfill the requirements of the electronic dealer
- 16 services system pursuant to section 60-1507; and
- 17 (16) For any other use specifically authorized by law that is
- 18 related to the operation of a motor vehicle or public safety.
